## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CERES AMENDING YEAR 1 OF THE MEASURE H TEN YEAR EXPENDITURE PLAN

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2007, City of Ceres' voters approved a ½-cent retail transaction and use tax (sales tax) for the improvement of police, fire and 9-1-1 emergency services; and
