

Residential Recycling Used Oil & Filters



Pour motor oil into a plastic screw top container.

Place drained oil filters in a plastic, sealable, see-through bag.



Place used oil and filter(s) two feet from blue can on your recycling day.

If you do not have residential garbage service or live in an apartment complex, please contact (800)-CLEANUP for the closest oil recycle center or ask where to recycle used oil when purchasing items.

What Goes into your Blue Recycle Can?

All **recyclable** materials including:

- Paper: Computer paper, stationary, newspaper, catalogs, phone books, and boxes (No pizza boxes or milk cartons)
- Metal Cans: steel, bi-metal or aluminum.
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic Containers: Water, soda and other containers with the recycle triangle and numbers 1-7
- California Redemption Value (CRV): bottles and cans with CRV or call (800) RECYCLE to find a recycle center near you



Mandatory Commercial Recycling and Organic Waste

Per State law, all **businesses** must have organic and recycling services.

Contact 209-538-5792 for information about the law and how to start service.

What Goes into your Green Garbage Can?

- **Grass** and plant clippings, weeds, other small green waste items
- No dirt or concrete
- Food Waste (*Try composting to conserve!*)
- Non-hazardous waste
- Non-recyclable metals or plastic

Residential Leaves/Limbs Collection

NO GRASS CLIPPINGS OR STUMPS

- Limbs must be less than 4 feet in length and 6 inches in diameter.
- **NO grass clippings, weeds, bark or dirt.**
- Piles must be placed loosely in the street no more than one week before your **blue** can service day.
- Removal occurs a few days after your **blue** can has been serviced.
- Report illegal dumping @ 209-538-5792



Residential Bulky Item Pick-Up

Pick-ups by appointment only!

Three Easy Steps:

Step 1) Contact Bertolotti @ 537-1500.

Step 2) State your address and items*.

**(Some items and addresses may not qualify for free disposal)*

Step 3) Place your items on the curb 24-hours before your pick-up.

Service provided twice per calendar year, per address, for **FREE**.

"Don't be a litter bug, avoid fines and make your appointment today."

Service Schedule

Match your zone (colored area) on the map with the calendar to find your recycling day.

Leaves/Limbs: piles are picked up the day after recycling followed by street sweeping services.
