Impounded Vehicles

Vehicle release fees are required for the following vehicle code sections authorizing impoundment:

22651 (a)	Unattended vehicle on a bridge.
22651 (b)	Highway Hazard
22651 (d)	Vehicle blocking a private driveway.
22651 (e)	Vehicle blocking a fire hydrant.
22651 (f)	Vehicle blocking freeway.
22651 (h)(1)	Driver was arrested.
22651 (h)(2)	Order of suspension or revocation pursuant to 23137
22651 (i)(1)	Multiple parking citations.
22651 (j)	Lack of vehicle registration.
22651 (k)	Parking over 72 hours.
22651 (l)	Parking in a construction zone.
22651 (m)	Violation of special event restriction.
22651 (n)	No parking zone
22651 (o)(1)	Delinquent vehicle registration.
22651 (p)	Driver unlicensed or license is suspended.
22651 (r)	Vehicle Blocking another vehicle.
22655.3	Removal for investigations (fleeing in violation of 2800.1 or 2800.2
22655.5(a)	Impounding vehicle for evidence (commit public offense)
22655.5(b)	Vehicle for evidence (vehicle itself evidence of a crime)
22669	Abandoned vehicle.
14602.6(a)	Suspended, revoked or unlicensed driver. 30 day hold.
14607.6(a)	Subject to forfeiture as a nuisance.

A vehicle release must be obtained in person at the Ceres Police Department, Records Division.

The following is required:

- The registered owner or their agent must be present with a VALID driver's License.
- If the registered owner does not possess a valid driver's license, he/she must have a VALID California DMV Identification card.
- Current registration for the impounded vehicle.
- A fee to be paid in CASH only for the release of the vehicle.

Fees \$180 for all impounded vehicles
