

STATION TOURS

Tours of Fire Station No. 1 are given year round. Tours include walking through the station and discovering how the firefighters live at their “second home,” checking out the fire trucks and fire equipment, and learning about fire safety.

Tours are generally given in the mornings to allow the firefighter’s time to get their training and other obligations completed, however, late afternoon and evening tours can also be conducted. Special tours of outlying stations may also be accommodated at the request of the on-duty Captain.

Some guidelines to follow when scheduling a tour:

- Groups should be kept to a manageable size - Sta. No. 1 can handle 30 kids, but it gets rather cramped at some of the outlying stations.
- Children should be chaperoned by adults - obviously, the younger the age group, the more chaperones needed.
- Have alternate plans in case the crews are called out of the station on an emergency.
