DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Developing Council Goals, prioritizing Projects and Programs for Fiscal Year 2011-12

Council identified the following as key projects and programs for Fiscal Year 2011-12:

- Reuse/Remodel of White Room
- Upgrade Phone System
- Landscape Medians – Mitchell North of Hatch
- Expand Affiliated Youth Sports Organization Program (City/District MOU)
- Whitmore Overcrossing Land Use Re-designation
- Additional Parking at Smyrna Park (current drainage area)
- CRBRP Expansion to include additional Soccer Fields or Tennis Courts
- Smyrna Park Restrooms
- Costa Fields Restrooms (will be finished soon)
- Comprehensive Update of Sign Ordinance
- Economic Development – Creating an Identity – Retail Opportunities – Retail Leakage
- Maintain the beautification of the downtown (flowers, landscaping etc.)

Need additional information/update on:

- Use of Redevelopment Funding to assist the School District with the installation of lighting and/or bleachers the Central Valley High School football field.
- Visual or Performing Arts Center.
- Resource Sharing Options – JPAs.
- Downtown Specific Plan – can we move forward on a few components to make it more attractive should the new Wal-Mart project be approved?
- Possibility of forming an improvement district to work on the undergrounding of utilities.
- Farmer's Market – Possibility of either extending the hours into the evening or combining it with the Concerts in the Park Series
- Lion's Park –CYSO has requested additional soccer fields. Would they be willing to utilize Lions Park for a couple of years and maintain it?
