DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Fowler Road at Lunar Road Stop Sign Discussion.

City Manager, Toby Wells, gave update on the intersection of Fowler Road and Lunar Road since the installation of the stop signs in April, 2013. Although studies show that the intersection does not meet the warrants for the installation of a multi-way stop sign, the stop sign is effective in reducing speeds on Fowler Road.

Ms. Jacobson also showed a video clip of cars going through the stop sign. Many cars slowed but did not come to a complete stop. Ms. Jacobson stated that the stop sign gives a false sense of security and is dangerous.

COUNCIL DIRECTION

Leave the stop sign in place as it does appear to be slowing traffic. Increase traffic enforcement in that area. Include this intersection as part of the Citywide Traffic Calming Policy staff is currently developing. Council also directed staff to bring to their attention any accidents that occur at this intersection.
