The undersigned person agrees that the above-named contractor/company will abide by the following rules:

1. A spanner wrench shall be the only type of wrench used on fire hydrants.
2. The above named person, contractor/company shall be liable for damages to all hydrants, associated water lines, and equipment which result from use of this equipment.
3. Water is to be used within the City of Ceres limits, or the area served by City water.
4. The vehicle/equipment must have an approved backflow device.
5. The meter shall be in place at all times during filling.
6. This permit must be in the vehicle at the time of fire hydrant use.
7. The user shall take water only from the fire hydrant designated by the Ceres Water Division.
8. The user shall provide a deposit for the meter and pay for water used.
9. **The meter is to be read or turned in after six (6) months. The maximum time to keep a City meter is 6 months. If not returned within six months, the Contractor's deposit is forfeited for the purchase of a replacement water meter.**
10. This permit is for the location noted above only. This meter may not be transferred to another site.
