The applicant further agrees that he/she shall take all necessary safety precautions reasonably required in performing any work pursuant to any permit granted by the City of Ceres, and specifically agrees to comply with any and all safety standards and rules that have been established by the State of California and/or the Federal Government. All oversized loads require warning signs. Please read the following requirements:

- Prior to start of work, a building permit will be required if applicable, (e.g., portable living space or movement of a house).
- The applicant agrees that requirements are subject to change based on field conditions.
- The applicant shall secure approvals from pertinent utility companies (telephone, cable and electrical).
- The applicant shall obtain necessary permits from Stanislaus County for county routes and CalTrans for state routes and overpasses.
- The applicant shall notify the City Public Safety Department at (209) 538-5712, at least one hour prior to moving through the City.

***Note: Movement of oversized loads in Ceres is not allowed during peak traffic hours: 7:00a.m. until 9:00a.m.; 12:00p.m. until 2:00p.m., including Ceres High School area, (Central and Whitmore Avenues – 2:00p.m. until 3:30p.m.); and 4:00p.m. until 6:00p.m.***
