This is an entry level position but experience in different building trades is preferred. Any additional experience demonstrating your mechanical dexterity and ability to troubleshoot hands-on may qualify. Ideally you have a high aptitude for electrical, plumbing and/or HVAC maintenance and repair. The full-time work schedule is only four days per week, ten hours per day for a desired work/life balance. The City offers some 100% premium paid health benefit options as well as a generous lifetime pension after vesting.

Responsibilities may include:

- Install new plumbing, repair & replace systems, fixtures such as facets, water heaters, urinals and piping
- Maintain, repair & replace electrical systems including light switches, outlets, card readers and electrical panels
- Perform painting work, masonry, flooring & general repair work on buildings and furniture
- Monitor & update HVAC control programs
- Perform carpentry, trim and finish work; frame walls, doors, windows; assemble shelving, furniture and cabinets
