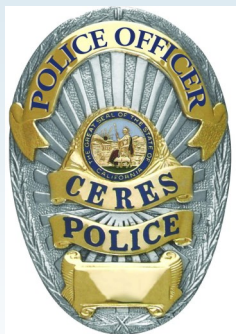

This is an exciting career and opportunity in Police to use your police skills and advance in your career to perform a wide variety of duties involving the enforcement of laws and the prevention of crimes; controls traffic flow and enforces state and local traffic regulation; issues citations; participates in and conducts a variety of criminal investigations; makes arrests; provide support and assistance to special crime prevention and law enforcement programs; and performs a variety of technical and administrative tasks in support of law enforcement services and activities.

Responsibilities may include: Patrol designated areas of the City, in car, by foot or other means to preserve law and order. Conduct investigations, testify in court hearings, provide administrative support, coordinate with other law enforcement agencies. Participate in special assignments including Field Training Officer, Swat, Crisis Negotiation Team, Detective, Canine Unit, School Resource Officer and other related assignments. Prepare and serve search and arrest warrants; apprehend and arrest offenders for crimes.

Summary Requirements (see job description for details):

Academy Level- Must be enrolled or attending POST certified basic law enforcement academy or possession of a valid POST certified basic academy.

Entry/Advanced Level- Some work experience as a California peace officer or other work experience that demonstrates a general aptitude for police work.

Lateral Transfer- Post Certified, currently employed at least one year as a sworn peace officer, possess a basic Post certificate. Must possess or be eligible to possess a Proof of Eligibility or certificate from California Peace Officer Standard and Training under SB2.

Applicants must submit a completed online City job application and supplemental questions by the filing deadline.
